# **Fabric Upholstery**

Cigarette test for invisible parts of upholstery according to Schedule 4 Part II for the Furniture and Furnishings (Fire) (Safety) Regulations 1988 amended 1989, 1993 and 2010 (SI 1988 / No. 1324, SI 1989/No. 2358, SI 1993/No. 207, SI 2010/No. 2205)

### Sample Identification

A cover material described by the customer as: Non-visible fabric used in ELEGANCE, ZYDAN, TUXEDO and CHELSEA.

The sample was tested in combination with a polyuyrethane foam which passes the ignitability test in Schedule 1 Part I as defined in Schedule 5 Part II of the Regulations (supplied by SATRA)

#### **Test Result**

The following test result relates only to the ignitability of the combination of upholstery composites under the particular conditions of test, it is not intended as a means of assessing the full potential fire hazard of the materials in use.

This material PASSED the cigarette test for invisible parts specified in Schedule 4 part II of the Furniture and Furnishings (Fire) (Safety) Regulations 1988, (amended 1989, 1993 and 2010).

A filling identified by the customer as: Back cushion loose fibre used in Roma, Valenica, Vancouver, Alhambra, Venice, Malaysian, Madrid, Sienna, Malagam, Manila, Zina, Shannon, Vaneza, Prada, Somerton and Cashmere.
